



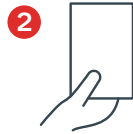
## Open Policy Process at #Lib2021

### Easy as 1-2-3

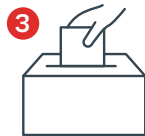

Workshops on Friday will allow convention attendees to **discuss and ask questions about policy resolutions.**



During the Open Policy Plenary on Saturday morning, eligible convention attendees will **vote yes or no on all 42 policy resolutions** (30 from the National Prioritization Vote, and 12 Fast Track resolutions) via polling during the plenary session.



Finally, during online balloted voting on Saturday afternoon, eligible convention attendees will **vote to prioritize the final set of policy ideas as party policy.** You will have 15 votes to cast as you like!

## How we got here:

Hundreds of policy resolutions were submitted from grassroots Liberals across Canada, and voted on by Registered Liberals within each province/territory, Commission, and Caucus. Over 6,000 Canadians took part before the convention even began!

A National Prioritization Vote open to all Registered Liberals selected the top 30 resolutions headed to convention, and each province/territory, Commission, and Caucus were able to designate a 'Fast-Track' resolution to head straight to plenary (12 Fast-Track resolutions were designated).
